This is the most exciting year that you have ever had in Faith Formation. You will receive two Sacraments for the first time:

**Reconciliation:** God Loves Us and Forgives Us When We Do Wrong

**Eucharist:** Christ Shares Himself with Us in the Bread and Wine of Eucharist

## A Family Affair

This is a year for the families of our sacrament children to actively participate in the sacramental preparations. Bring your child to Sunday Mass each week. The Mass is where families come together to worship and to build their relationship with God and with the community.

### You are expected to attend the following events with your child:

- Parent / Child Workshops October 17<sup>th</sup> & April 2<sup>nd</sup>
- First Reconciliations Nov. 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup>
- A Walk Through the Mass March 1<sup>st</sup>
- First Eucharist May 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>

*Your child's regular attendance at Faith Formation sessions is expected. Missed lessons can be completed at home, with the catechist and the CM office notified of the make up. Contact the CM office for workshop or special*

### Group Sessions

#### **First semester children will prepare for First Reconciliation and will learn:**

- We Belong to God, We Follow Jesus, We Listen to the Holy Spirit
- We are Sorry, We are Forgiven, We are Peacemakers

#### **Second semester children will learn within the context of the Mass:**

- We Belong to a Community and We Gather at the Mass
- We Listen to God's Word in the Old and New Testament
- We give Thanks, We Remember His Sacrifice and Celebrate (the Eucharist)
- We Go Forth to Love and Serve

This is a full year with many dates to remember and forms to be completed. We must have a completed Sacrament Information Form in the office by Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> with a copy of your child's Baptismal Certificate or Profession of Faith if applicable. If your child has not been baptized or has been baptized in another faith, call Raylene Juneau as soon as possible. Please come to the activities and do not hesitate to call with any questions that you might have. I am happy to talk to you and want to help to make this a memorable year for your child and for you.
